2023 CHAMBER FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP



The Kenosha Area Chamber of Commerce Foundation awards scholarships to students that display positive character, leadership skills, academic excellence, community involvement, and future aspirations.

OVERVIEW

A minimum of four (4) scholarships in amounts of \$2,500 each will be awarded to graduating high school seniors pursuing a full-time course of study at a four-year college/university or technical college.

Funds will be dispersed over the first two years during the fall term directly to the four-year college/university or technical college upon the Chamber receiving a course schedule from the applicant.

Scholarships will be awarded at the students' high school graduating awards banquet.

QUALIFICATIONS

- · Kenosha County resident
- · Graduating high school senior
- Must have a connection to the Kenosha Area Chamber of Commerce either through a member employer or a parent/guardian's employer.
- Applicants must have a minimum Grade Point
 Average (GPA) of 2.5/4.0, or have shown considerable
 improvement in their academic performance. Applicants
 with a GPA below 2.5 must submit a written statement
 explaining why they should be considered despite not
 meeting the minimum GPA requirement.
- Applicants must participate in extracurricular activities.
 This may include apprenticeships, co-op programs, work experience, athletics, art, clubs, etc.
- Applicants must have demonstrated community involvement. This could include religious organizations, community groups, volunteer work, or other involvement.

WRITTEN STATEMENT

Please attach a typewritten statement (two pages or less) explaining your experiences and aspirations that include:

- Leadership
- Community involvement
- Extracurricular activities (arts, sports, clubs, work, etc.)
- Honors, awards and/or recognitions
- What you have personally and professionally gained from your experiences
- · Future aspirations
